Header: Apply now to use NOP waiver when new Windsor Framework arrangements come into effect

Dear trader

The Windsor Framework introduces simplified processes for Internal Market movements. This simplifies the process for moving goods from Great Britain into Northern Ireland.

The Notification of Presentation (NOP) waiver forms part of this simplified process and our records show you're eligible to apply for this waiver. Having a NOP waiver means you won't need to present goods to customs before you move your goods, when using Entry in Declarant Records (EIDR).

When you can use the NOP waiver

You can waive NOP requirements for EIDR movements where the goods are:

- moving from Great Britain to Northern Ireland directly
- standard goods that aren't at risk of onward movement to the EU.

How to use your NOP waiver

If you're moving goods via the Goods Vehicles Movement Service (GVMS), tell your haulier to use your NOP waiver for movements, to waive the requirement for additional information on GVMS.

At inventory-linked ports (ILPs), present your NOP waiver to waive the requirement for a Customs Clearance Request (C21)

Apply for a NOP waiver

You can <u>apply for a NOP waiver</u> because you are established in Northern Ireland and

- you hold either a valid Authorised Economic Operator Authorisation Customs simplifications or hold a combination of AEOC and AEOS - AEO Security and Safety (AEOS)
- you have an EIDR for movements into Northern Ireland or a UKIMS-EIDR authorisation.

We contacted you in November because our records showed that you're eligible to apply for a Notification of Presentation (NOP) waiver.

Our records show that you haven't yet applied. Having an NOP waiver means you won't need to present goods to customs before you move your goods, when using Entry in Declarant Records (EIDR).

You can also waive NOP requirements for EIDR movements where these goods are:

- moving from Great Britain to Northern Ireland directly
- standard goods that aren't at risk of onward movement to the EU.

If you're moving goods via Goods Vehicles Movement Service (GVMS), you can tell your haulier to use your NOP waiver for movements, to waive the requirement for additional information on GVMS. At inventory-linked ports (ILPs), you'll be able to waive the requirement for a Customs Clearance Request(C21)), if you present a valid NOP waiver.
