As part of this, the UKIMS-EIDR authorisation will let UKIMS authorised traders apply for their own Entry in Declarant's Record (EIDR) authorisation.

You can apply now to use UKIMS-EIDR.

What the UKIMS-EIDR authorisation could mean for you

When new Windsor Framework arrangements for freight and parcels come into effect you'll be able to benefit from the EIDR process but with a simpler application process.

You won't have to submit any information before you move goods. Instead, you'll store information about the movement in your own records. After you've moved your goods, you can use a simpler dataset to complete your declaration.

What you can use UKIMS-EIDR for

You can only use UKIMS-EIDR to move standard goods via direct transport from GB to NI. These goods must also be not at risk of onward movement into the EU. Goods listed under DEFRA Northern Ireland Retail Movement Scheme (NIRMS), can also be moved into NI using EIDR.

You can't use UKIMS-EIDR for goods that have a licence, requirement or control that needs to be enforced at the border in NI. For example, licensable goods such as live animals.

How to apply for UKIMS-EIDR

You'll need to <u>apply online</u> using your UKIMS authorisation number and provide your XI EORI. You'll also need to name the person who'll be responsible for identifying errors in your records and telling us about any difficulties meeting the requirements of the scheme. HMRC will notify you when you will be able to use this process.
