Food Fraud Cases

In the “Operation Garden”, the Guardia Civil dismantled a criminal group selling since 2013 fake saffron, which was in reality modified gardenia extracts imported from China. The criminals invented an innovative technique aiming at almost eliminating the only molecule distinguishing saffron from gardenia. Harvest price for gardenia is ten times lower than for saffron; anyhow, gardenia is not considered a food in the European Union. Labels and customs documentation were falsified as well. The authorities seized 2 tons of fake saffron (total value of more than 750 000 Euros).

The Directorate-General for Competition, Consumer Affairs and Fraud Control (DGCCRF) has investigated the authenticity of foie gras. Numerous non-conformities were noted by the DGCCRF investigators in 46% of the establishments checked. The non-compliance rate was 28% for foie gras blocks and 75% for foie gras products.

Recurrent non-compliances included *inter alia*:

- Mislabelling of the country of origin
- Presence of unauthorised additives
- Presence of excessive moisture, added water and/or fat content
- Incomplete labels
- Lack of traceability documentation
- Misuse of Geographical Indications

chemometrics and Fourier transform infrared (FT-IR) spectroscopy (99% accuracy) in order to detect fake eggs. Fake egg white and yolk can be artificially created with sodium alginate, gelatin, and colourings, whereas fake shells can be built with calcium chloride.
